Grand Strand Saltwater Anglers Association FLOUNDER TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Eligible Fish: Flounder and Bluefish caught by rod and reel in Murrells Inlet on tournament day. All SCDNR fishing regulations apply. (*SEE RULE 10*)
- 2. Only one major Flounder prize per angler. Tagged Flounder can only be entered in Tagged Flounder contest. All ties by weight will be determined by length.
- 3. There will only be one (1) weigh-in station for all registered anglers, located at Murrells Inlet Public Ramp Parking Lot. Weigh-in is from 3 pm to 5pm and the scale will be closed at 5 pm.
- 4. All Flounder and Bluefish must be brought to the weigh-in station accompanied with the angler's tournament number.
- 5. No cut or mutilated Flounder or Bluefish will be accepted.
- 6. The committee reserves the right to dissect the winning Flounders and Bluefish.
- 7. No lines in the water before 6 am.
- 8. All Flounder and Bluefish must be caught inside Murrells Inlet on the day of the tournament. The Jetties are the boundary.
- 9. No congregating during the tournament, except for rendering aid to another boat. Committee must be notified.

10. ALL FLOUNDER WEIGHED IN MUST BE 16-INCH MINIMUM. ONLY ONE FLOUNDER WEIGHED IN PER ANGLER. ONLY ONE BLUEFISH WEIGHED IN PER ANGLER.

- 11. Youth angler must be 14 or younger, and listed on his or her own registration form.
- 12. Boats with mechanical problems may return to the ramp to notify the committee by phone, repairs can be made and the boat can return to fishing.
- 13. The \$1,500 Tagged Flounder Prize will be equally divided among the anglers who weigh-in DNR numbered Tournament Tagged Flounder. Winner must be present with valid picture identification.
- 14. Tournament number must be displayed at all times.
- 15. ALL FISHERMEN MUST ATTEND THE CAPTAIN'S MEETING TO RECEIVE THEIR TOURNAMENT NUMBER AND ANY RULE CHANGES THAT MAY OCCUR.
- 16. All decisions by the rules committee are final.
